

Safety Regulations for Forwarding Agents

The following specifications are to be followed by all drivers. They are part of the concluded freight contract!

Occupational safety

- a) Wearing of a warning vest
- b) Wearing of safety shoes;
- c) Smoking prohibition on the entire company grounds, incl. inside vehicles

Freight protection:

ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH points out that all drivers have to consider the specifications relating to proper freight protection during the loading and unloading. This means that the goods to be loaded have to be secured form-fitting and/or force-locking.

1. The drivers are required to show the loading personnel of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH corresponding certificates of the semi-trailer being driven, according to VDI 2700 ff., without being asked to do so. If the semi-trailer should not correspond to the specifications or a form-fitting and/or force-locking securing is not provided, further freight protection measures are necessary. We request that you consider this regarding time taken with the loading.
2. Freight protection aid resources according to VDI 2700 ff. are to be made available on the part of the forwarding agency.
The loading personnel of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH are instructed to ensure that the freight protection is in compliance with specifications.
Please understand that, effective immediately, only those vehicles which meet the above-mentioned prerequisites will be loaded.
3. For technical reasons of liability, external freight will be neither unloaded nor reloaded by the employees of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH.
4. If the secured shipment should be subsequently reloaded or unsecured on the part of the forwarding agency, any liability on the part of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH in cases of damage is excluded.
5. All pallets and packages of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH cannot be stacked!
6. Furthermore, photographs will be recorded for documentation of the secured shipment and the truck number plate.

Handling of the goods of ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH:

On basis of the freight contract, with the loading, ARGUS Additive Plastics GmbH hands over their goods on trust to the forwarding agent until their unloading. The forwarding agent has the responsibility of ensuring that any access by inadmissible third parties, in particular any sampling, is excluded.

Rules of conduct on the ARGUS premises

1. Drivers must report to the signposted reporting points on the premises before loading or unloading.
2. The road traffic regulations and a maximum speed of 10 km/h apply on the entire ARGUS premises.
3. Vehicles may only be parked in the areas specified by warehouse personnel and must not block escape and rescue routes with their vehicles.
4. The engine must be switched off during loading.
5. Drivers may not move freely on the company premises without being accompanied by an employee.

Rules of conduct on the customer's premises

The customer's rules of conduct, which may be communicated to the driver/forwarding agent, e.g. customer-specific hygiene guidelines, must be observed when delivering to the customer.

Environmental protection

1. The vehicle must be in a proper condition to be approved for loading on the company premises. Appropriate measures will be taken in the event of non-compliance.
2. Waste disposal on the ARGUS premises is not permitted.
3. If the product is damaged during loading or transportation, it must be ensured that it is not released into the environment. ARGUS is part of the zero granulate loss initiative: https://www.argus-additive.de/cx-content/uploads/TN_Bestätigung_Null-Granulatverlust_Argus_2022_d-1.pdf
